COOKE, Robert, died ca. 1728. To Chaptico, Maryland, 1720. M. Sarah Fielding. Son John, born 1726. (C.A.G., i, 686)

COOPER, Ann, aged 21. From Wick, Caithness. To New York on Commerce, ex Greenock, 10 Feb., 1774. Spinster. (T.47/12) 1109

COOPER, James, aged 3. From New Luce, Wigtonshire. Probably related to Janet McMiken (q.v.) To New York on Jackie, ex Stranraer, 31 May, 1775. (T. 47/12)

COOPER, Mary. Settled Mechanicsville, Pennsylvania, before 1783. M. Philip Clover, born Sussex County, New Jersey, 1758, with issue: (1) Martha, born 25 Sept., 1783; (2) Catherine, born 5 July, 1786; (3) John, born 29 Aug., 1789; (4) Peter, born 5 Dec., 1790; (5) Nathan, born 16 Aug., 1792; (6) Philip, born 6 June, 1795; (7) James, 4 Oct., 1797; (8) Gamaliel, born 6 Apr., 1799. COOPER, Mary. Probably from Perthshire. Emigrated 1839. (D.A.B., xi, 512)

COOPER, Patrick. Jacobite prisoner. Transported to Maryland on Friendship, ex Liverpool, 24 May, 1716. (S.P./C.)

COOPER, Thomas, aged 4. From New Luce, Wigtonshire. Probably related to Janet McMiken (q.v.) To New York on Jackie, ex Stranraer, 31 May, 1775. (T.47/12)

COPELAND, John, died ca. 1830. Probably from Urr, Kirkcudbrightshire. Son of Robert C. and Margaret Boder. To New York, 1774. Blacksmith. M. Sarah Martin, with issue: (1) Robert; (2) Rachel; (3) Margaret; (4) George, born 1783; (5) Mary; (6) Hannah; (7) Jean; (8) Betsey; (9) Alexander, born 1797. (D.C., 29 Nov., 1965)

COPELAND, Robert. Jacobite prisoner. Transported to Virginia on Elizabeth & Anne, ex Liverpool, 29 June, 1716. (S.P./C.; S.N.Q., iv, 187)

CORBET, John. To Perth Amboy, East New Jersey, 1685. (D.C., 2 Apr., 1963)

CORBETT, Edward, aged 20. From Edinburgh to Charleston, South Carolina on Countess, ex Greenock, 14 Oct., 1774. Merchant. (T. 47/12)

CORBITT, Andrew. Prisoner in Leith Tolbooth. Transported to Perth Amboy, East New Jersey on Henry & Francis, ex Leith, 5 Sept., 1685. (R. P. C., xi/3, 154; D. C., 2 Apr., 1971)

CORDINER, James, died before 19 Mar., 1724. From Paisley. Son of James C. To Rappahannock, Virginia, before 1720. Merchant. (E.R.T.) 1120

CORHEAD, Agnes. Prisoner in Leith tolbooth. Bantshed to New Jersey but died on board the Henry & Francis, ex Leith, 5 Sept., 1685. (R. P. C., xi/3, 154; D. C., 2 Apr., 1963)
