Last Will and Testament of James Henry

I know all men by these presents, that I, James Henry of Springdale in the County of Washington and State of Arkansas, being of sound mind do make and Publish this my last will and Testament, hereby Revoking any and all wills by me at any time heretofore made.

It is my will that my funeral shall be conducted without pomp or any unnecessary expensation and that the expenses thereof together with all my just debts be fully paid.

It is my will that my executor, as soon as possible after my death, sell all my property, both Real and personal and after paying all my just debts, to give my Wife Alfreda Henry, and then the balance of the amount remaining.

I give and devise to the heirs of my deceased daughter Mrs. Elmina L. Newton, the sum of one dollar each.

I give and devise the remainder of my estate to my remaining five children, as follows:

- One fifth to my son C. Lee Henry, one fifth to my son John L. Henry, one fifth to the legal heirs of my deceased daughter, Mrs. Rosie C. Ross, one fifth to my daughter Mrs. Ladora L. Burkhardt and one fifth to my daughter Mrs. Ladora L. Burkhardt.
