whereof and that this Court, is satisfied that the said Thomas Clayton has not any property or estate whatever whereof to make a Schedule and that on the 18th of March 1818 nor at any time since before, any property, or estate or income directly or interest except the money of the value of \$40 or 50 which it is proven he parted with in 1819. to discharge a debt he owed to R. D. Johnson for new papers, all which is Order to be recorded and Certified.

Ordered that William ^{G. Garrity} ~~Donah~~ Stephen L Logan & Samuel Edgar, is appointed as Justices to grant Writs of Injunctions & ex parte for the County of Barren.

Ordered that John L. Davis, and John L. Woodson be appointed to view the nearest best way for a road to be opened from the Westwardly end of the Bridge erected across Shaggs Creek below the state ford to intersect the state road at the most suitable place and make report to the Court.


Ordered that John Glover Henry Critcher Wm. Garrity & John Perkins be appointed any three to view the nearest best way for a road from the Bridge erected across Shaggs Creek below the state ford, beginning at the east end of S. bridge and intersect the state road at the most suitable place and a direction to Glasgow & that they make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Rebecca no Elizabeth Richardson (and others) as her security as shown of that Richardson continued till next Court.

Ordered that James Walters Stephen Burdick Johnson Owen John Garrison be appointed Commissioners they or any three being sworn do appraise in current money the personal Estate and slaves if any of John Davis Dec^r and return and inventory thereof to the Court.

Dispositions of Fanny Will it is Ordered that she be released from her indenture binding her to Samuel Martin & that this said Martin be released on his part, from any responsibility for any damages against him in consequence of S. indenture.

Ordered that Fanny Will be bound by W. Logan Clerk of this Court to Thomas Freeman until she arrives to the age of eighteen years of age to learn the business of house keeping spinning &c.
