


Memorandum William T Bush


278. Memorandum of an agreement entered into this 11th of May 1816 between Nelson Will Robert R Will, James Will, Lawrence Fitzgerald and Susanna his wife and Henry Davis of the County of Barren and State of Kentucky of the one part and William T Bush of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said Bush hath this day undertaken to sue for and Collect for the aforesaid Nelson Will Brothers Heirs Representatives of Mary Ann Will Decedent a Legacy left to the said Mary Ann Will by James Canterbury in his last Will and Testament and whereas the said William T Bush at his own proper Cost and Charges agrees to sue for and recover said Legacy Consisting of Lands and other Estate left by the said Canterbury in his last Will and Testament to the said Mary Ann Will without the aid Representatives of the said Mary Ann being at any expense or Cost on their part They hereby agree and promise to give and allow the said William T Bush one third part of whatever sum he may Recover and receive which which third part he is to have for his trouble and expenses and the other two thirds the said Bush is to pay over to the aforesaid Representatives or persons legally authorized to receive the same I Witness we have set our hands and seals this date above written
