Fitzgarald To Hill Know all men by these presents that we Lawrence FitzJarul and William Ramsey are held and firmly bound unto Robert Brooke Esq. Governor or chief magistrate of the State of Virginia and to his successors in office in the just and full sum of 150 Dollars to the payment of which we bind ourselves jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and Dated this 7th day of April 1796.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas there is a marriage suddenly intended to be had & solemnized between the above bound Lawrence Fitzgarald & Susannah Hill now if there should be no lawful cause or impediment to obstruct the said marriage then the obligation to be void else to remain in full force & virtue.
